### DESCRIPTION

- **Programme description**

The Wallonia-Brussels International Excellence Grants Programme (IN WBI) enables the Universities of the Wallonia-Brussels Federation to receive foreign researchers for Postdoctoral studies or Postdoctoral research programmes.

Awards of:

- ◇ **Long-term** scholarships (minimum 1 year, renewable once) at postdoctoral level.
- ◇ **Short-term** scholarships (1 to 3 months, non-renewable) at postdoctoral level.

## WALLONIA-BRUSSELS INTERNATIONAL EXCELLENCE GRANTS

### APPLICATION

### DEADLINE

- **For long-term scholarships:**

No later than the **1<sup>st</sup> of March** preceding the academic year during which the stay is requested.

- **For short-term scholarships:**

- ◇ For stays starting between February and May: no later than the preceding **1<sup>st</sup> of October**.
- ◇ For stays starting between June and September: no later than the preceding **1<sup>st</sup> of February**.
- ◇ For stays starting between October and January: no later than the preceding **1<sup>st</sup> of May**.

### FINANCIAL

### ARRANGEMENTS

- **For long-term scholarships:**

Monthly amount 1200 euros covering living expenses, accommodation, educational materials and travel expenses within the country.

- ◇ WBI will cover international travel costs (one round trip for the total duration of the programme).
- ◇ WBI covers "healthcare" insurance for non-EU fellows.
- ◇ WBI takes responsibility for "repatriation assistance insurance".
- ◇ Intervention in doctoral registration fees for a maximum amount of 835 euros.

**For short-term scholarships:**

- ◇ Monthly amount 1300 euros covering living expenses, accommodation, educational materials and travel expenses within the country;
- ◇ WBI will cover international travel costs (one round trip for the total duration of the programme);
- ◇ WBI covers "healthcare" insurance for non-EU fellows.
